College Credit in High School

KJSHS and New Frontier Students have an amazing opportunity to take college classes for both high school and college credit! These classes are offered through a combination of concurrent and dual enrollment options. Not only can students take these classes, they are also free to the student. BOCES pays for the classes, fees, and books. Students and parents can visit with the high school counselors and BOCES to learn more. Students must be in 11th or 12th grade, have a minimum GPA of 3.25, and be approved by their counselor to be eligible.

Dual Enrollment provides the opportunity for Lincoln County School District #1 high school students to take online college classes for high school and college credit. Students are scheduled in the computer lab during their dual enrollment class and learn online from a Western Wyoming Community College instructor. Students must be approved to take classes by their high school counselor and register through BOCES. There are a number of internet classes WWCC offers. (Building a foundation through community education & skill sets)



ED2GO non-credit classes.

Update your skills, discover a new talent, or chart a new career path at your own pace and convenience!

These instructor-facilitated online courses are informative, fun, convenient and highly interactive. All courses run for six weeks (with a two-week grace period at the end). Courses are project oriented and include lessons, quizzes, hands-on assignments, discussion areas, supplementary links and more.

How to Get Started:

1. Visit our Online Instruction Center at: www.ed2go.com/kemmoutreach
2. Click the Orientation link and follow the instructions to enroll and pay for your course. You will be prompted to choose the name and password you will use to access your online course. This step is critical! You cannot access your course until you complete orientation.
3. When your course starts, return to our Online Instruction Center and click the Classroom link. To begin your studies, simply log in with the name and password you provided during orientation.
4. When you finish your class remember to print your certificate.

Ed2Go classes approved for Professional Teaching Standards Board (PTSB)

To substitute teach in Wyoming, you must apply for a **Substitute Teacher Permit**. This permit is valid for five years and is eligible for renewal. In order to **reinstate a lapsed permit**, you must acquire five (5) semester hours of transcript credit or other professional development credit as approved by PTSB. Students can take any **education** related course. Each Ed2Go course listed is worth 1.5 units, 7 units of Ed2Go will equal .5 credits towards the 5 credits needed.
