ED2GO Non-Credit Classes:

Update your skills, discover a new talent, or chart a new career path at your own pace and at your convenience! Our instructor-facilitated online courses are informative, fun, convenient and highly interactive. All courses run for six weeks (with a two-week grace period at the end). Courses are project oriented and include lessons, quizzes, hands-on assignments, discussion areas, supplementary links and more.

How to Get Started:

1. Visit our Online Instruction Center at: www.ed2go.com/kemmoutreach
2. Click the Orientation link and follow the instructions to enroll and pay for your course. You will also be provided an opportunity to choose the name and password you will use to access your online course. This step is critical! You cannot access your course until you complete orientation.
3. When your course starts, return to our Online Instruction Center and click the Classroom link. To begin your studies, simply log in with the name and password you provided during orientation.

Approved Ed2Go Courses for Professional Teaching Standards Board:

To substitute teach in Wyoming, you must apply for a Substitute Teacher Permit. This permit is valid for five years and is eligible for renewal. In order to reinstate a lapsed permit, you must acquire five (5) semester hours of transcript credit or other professional development credit as approved by PTSB. Students can take any education related course. Each Ed2Go course listed is worth 1.5 units, 7 units of Ed2Go will equal .5 credits towards the 5 credits needed.
